

Young WSÁNEĆ Woman Leader Award

Donor: Dr. Taiaiake Alfred

Value: 1 at \$1000

Criteria: To support a female student from the local WSÁNEĆ communities who has been active in the community, who has demonstrated leadership capacity or potential, and who intends to pursue post-secondary education and/or engage in Indigenous resurgence and activism. This will be awarded to a graduating student from ILC, SIDES, Stelly's, Parkland or Claremont Secondary School who:

1. Meets graduation requirements in the current school year;
2. Has overcome challenges and displays the determination to be successful in school;
3. Has demonstrated leadership, or the capacity to be a leader, in the school or community; and
4. Intends to pursue education at a post-secondary institution and/or engage in leadership in Indigenous resurgence and activism.

Deadline: **May 15, 2020**

Procedure: Students should submit the following documents to the school Scholarship Counsellor:

1. A cover letter detailing how the student meets the award criteria and including a statement of future goals and plans
2. A transcript of grade 11 and 12 marks
3. Completed District Scholarship Application Form

Selection: Selection will be made by the School District 63 Scholarship Committee in consultation with Dr. Alfred.
